



# School Safety— Active Shooter Training

*“KEDC... Leading Tomorrow. Today.”*

*This program provides an updated look at the acts of violence and safety concerns within the educational facility. The session provides the audience with a variety of “best practice” methods for hardening these targets, as well as methodical mental preparation to identify and react to an emergency situation. Proper mental preparation enables those faced with such a situation, to perceive and react in a more controlled and rational manner. A portion of this instructional block is focused specifically on active shooter response.*

*ICS is a standardized on-scene incident management concept designed specifically to allow School Personnel the ability to adopt an integrated organizational structure equal to the complexity and demands of any single incident or multiple incidents without being hindered by jurisdictional boundaries. School Personnel will be introduced operating a School Emergency (Emergency Response Center) with a unified command with emergency first responders.*

**DAY 1—Classroom Training - 6 hours**

**DAY 2—Hands on learning - participating in an active shooting as the victims in this scenario.** KY State Police, Ashland Police Dept and the Boyd County Sheriff Office will be acting as the first responders to a school shooting. As a participant, you will experience the dynamics of the active school shooting as it plays out in this mock scenario.

### Audience:

***This School Safety Training will provide the participants with actual hands-on training with an active mock school shooting.***

The objectives of the workshop include:

1. Understanding the current trends and dangers of workplace violence.
2. Understanding awareness of PPT (People, Places, Things) as potential risks.
3. Understand the 3 step process of situational awareness
4. Increase overall awareness of workplace violence and other safety risks.
5. Learn skills to avert a workplace violence event.
